Indications

ascodryl® Expectorants are drugs, which have been proposed to be useful in loosening and liquefying mucous in soothing irritated bronchial mucosa and in making coughs more productive. ascodryl® is recommended for clinical relief of cough associated with bronchitis, bronchial asthma, emphysema and other bronchopulmonary disorders where bronchospasm, mucus plugging and problems of expectoration co-exist.

Cough associated with Acute and Chronic Bronhitis, Emphysema, Active and Passive Smoking; Pulmonary TB and other Bronchospastic Disorders are treated by terbutaline+guaiphenesin+bromhexine+menthol.

Dosage

Adults: 10-20 ml

Children below 6 yrs: 5 ml

6-12 yrs: 10 ml For all: Thrice in day

Contraindications

Terbutaline+guaiphenesin+bromhexine+menthol Syrup is contraindicated with known hypersensitivity to any component of the syrup.

Side Effects

Side effects may occur occasionally with bromhexine and a transient rise in serum aminotransferase values has been reported. Other reported adverse effects include headache, vertigo (dizziness), sweating and allergic reactions.
