Emergency, Contraceptive, Pill, Gpill, **G-pill**, ECP, conceive, Conception, Morning after, Unintended pregnancy, Female condoms, Sex, Unwanted pregnancy, ...

G-pill is an oral tablet. It should be swallowed with some water within 72 hours of unprotected sex to prevent pregnancy. It is advisable to take G-pill after meals to prevent vomiting. If you vomit within three hours of taking G-pill, you should take another G-pill as soon as possible. G-pill should not be used if you are already pregnant because it is only a backup or emergency method of contraception. It is not as effective as other regular birth control methods. G-pill is not recommended if you are allergic to levonorgestrel.

Important safety aspects: G-pill is neither a regular contraceptive nor an abortion pill. It is not a substitute for condoms and does not protect against sexually transmitted diseases including HIV/AIDS.
